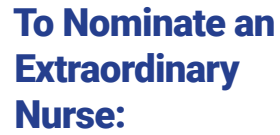

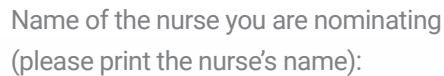


Want to say thank you to your nurse?
